Operation Christmas Child 2018 Wrap Up

I would like to thank you for your tremendous support of Operation Christmas Child this year. Because of your generous contribution of shoeboxes and financial support at least 230 children will experience God's love in a tangible way. They will also hear the Gospel and have an opportunity to accept Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. What a joyous thing it is to spread the Good News.

Also this year our church took on an additional role with Operation Christmas Child. We served as a drop-off site where shoeboxes created by other churches and individuals were brought. Volunteers counted the boxes, recorded information from donors and placed the boxes in cartons. We packed 1033 shoeboxes in 67 cartons. These cartons plus one containing filler items were then loaded onto a donated truck and transported to the central drop-off site located in Geneva. The cartons were loaded onto a waiting semi which left the next day for a processing center in North Carolina. Soon those who used the "Follow Your Box" labels will be able to see where their box's journey ends.

It has been a busy Operation Christmas Child season, and I know that we are entering a very busy Advent/Christmas season, but I ask you to continue to pray for Operation Christmas Child. Pray that our boxes and donations would bring God Glory, that they are brought safely to their destination, and that they can be used by God to meet the spiritual and physical needs of each child who receives a box. May God Bless you for your part in this ministry and Merry Christmas!

Used stamps still needed to support missions

Are you remembering to clip and bring in your used stamps? The Alliance Stamp Ministry has exceeded earning one million dollars from the sale of the stamps to wholesalers since the mission inception in 1972.

The money is given to subsidize the ministry of Publicaciones Alianza, a publisher in Argentina of Christian Spanish language Sunday School materials. These are used by over 40 denominations in eight Latin American countries, Spain, and the United States. These materials help teachers clearly give the Gospel to children. About 60 residents of the Shell Point Retirement Community in Ft. Myers, Florida meet each Tuesday and Friday to clip, sort, and pack the stamps that we and others send them.

Any cancelled stamp is accepted even computer generated, torn, or wrinkled. Leave ¼" or 1/3" border when you clip them off the envelope and deposit them in the container provided in the foyer.


