Jefferson First Baptist Has a New Pastor

WE HAVE A NEW PASTOR!! On June 3, Pastor Kevin Phillips will preach his first sermon as the new pastor of Jefferson First Baptist Church. Kevin, Brenda, Daniel, Emma, and Lila are moving from Madison, Wisconsin and will be living in the church parsonage in Jefferson, Ohio. They should be here about May 31 or June 1. That came about as the result of a unanimous vote on Wednesday, April 4, but more so as a result of the faith and obedience of you, the congregation, and of your Leadership Team.

One year ago in the April 2017 Baptiscope, I wrote the following opening paragraph: "The days, weeks, and months ahead could be monumental in the life of Jefferson First Baptist Church--maybe more important than any other time in the past 100 years or more." In many ways, I believe that to be true. We have a new pastor coming, and even though nobody in our congregation would have believed it in April of 2017, we are no longer an American Baptist Church.

The Leadership Team has served First Baptist well by faithfully meeting <u>every</u> two weeks for the past year. Each time they have met, they have taken almost the first half hour sharing how God was working in their lives and then they all prayed. We are now seeing the fruit of their prayers and the fruit of their work. And I believe that you (the congregation) have also served First Baptist well. Foremost in the way you have served is also through your prayers. You have made prayer a first priority just as A. J. Gordon has suggested, "You can do more than pray after you have prayed; but you can never do more than pray until you have prayed." And you have prayed the way that 1 John 5:14 tells us to pray, "This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us." You have continuously prayed for God's will to be done.

In the April 2017 Baptiscope, I also quoted Matthew 16:18 where Jesus promised Peter, "I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it." The invisible church of God will always exist on this earth until Jesus comes back to claim his own people, and we at Jefferson First Baptist want to be a part of that work until Jesus returns.
