VBS is fast approaching! Our theme is Shipwrecked, Jesus Rescues!

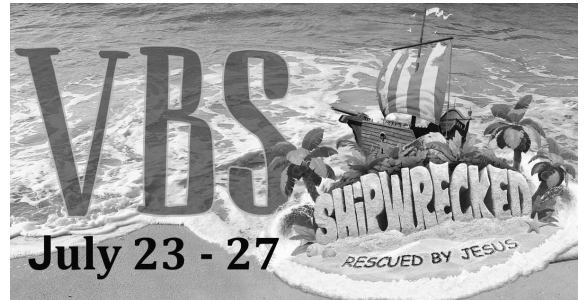
