Danny and Doris Havens are moving to New York state this December in order to live closer to their son Bruce and his family. Danny and Doris were lifetime residents of Jefferson and also have a long history at First Baptist Church of Jefferson.

Danny's mother, Dorothy, moved to Jefferson in 1927, and began attending church here at First Baptist shortly thereafter. After Danny was born in 1939, he began attending FBC and continued to attend FBC his whole life. When Danny was in high school, Danny used to stoke the coal furnace of the church for heat during the cold season and throughout his time at FBC. He served in many roles, including superintendent of Sunday School, serving as a deacon, helping with the building as a Trustee, and singing many years in the choir.

Danny's wife Doris equally leaves behind a long legacy at FBC. Doris served as director of the choir for over 30 years, as well as directing Vacation Bible School for at least four years, teaching youth and adult Sunday School classes, and serving in the women's missionary circles. She was also one of four ladies who made dinner for Family Night on Wednesday evenings. This ran for 4 years, Sept. through April, in the early 1970's. As the former CEO of Lakeview Federal Credit Union, Doris used her financial planning skills to help with the church finances.


